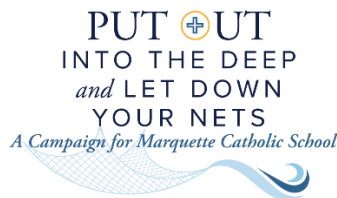

***A Lent to Remember*** Explores the ways God reaches out to each of us with his mercy. By reflecting on the Paschal Mystery and making a step-by-step examination of the Rite of Confession, *A Lent to Remember* communicates God's invitation to each one of us to come experience his indescribable love this Lent.
